General Data Protection Regulations (GDPR) and Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure and all personal data is collected and handled according to GDPR. In order to prevent unauthorised access or disclosure, we have put in place suitable physical, electronic and managerial procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect online.

Core Communications Europe Ltd may send you information on our service. All individuals are provided with the opportunity to

opt out of receiving information from us, or having their details passed on to other organisations at any stage.

What information do we collect?

We may collect, store and use the following kinds of personal information:

- information about your computer and about your visits to and use of this website (including your IP address, geographical location, browser type and version, operating system, referral source, length of visit, page views and website navigation);
- information that you provide to us for the purpose of registering with us
- information that you provide to us for the purpose of subscribing to our website services, email notifications and/or newsletters
- any other information that you choose to send to us;

Cookies

A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

This enables the web server to identify and track the web browser.

We may use both "session" cookies and "persistent" cookies on the website. Session cookies will be deleted from your computer when you close your browser. Persistent cookies will remain stored on your computer until deleted, or until they reach a specified expiry date.

We will use the session cookies to: keep track of you whilst you navigate the website; keep track of items in your shopping basket; prevent fraud and increase website security.

We will use the persistent cookies to: enable our website to recognise you when you visit; keep track of your preferences in relation to your use of our website.

We use Google Analytics to analyse the use of this website, to generate statistical and other information about website use by means of cookies, which are stored on users' computers. The information generated relating to our website is used to create reports about the use of the website. Google will store this

Most browsers allow you to reject all cookies, whilst some browsers allow you to reject just third party cookies.

Using your personal information

Personal information submitted to us via this website or our electronic newsletters will be used for the purposes specified in this privacy policy or in relevant parts of the website.

We may use your personal information to:

- send you general (non-marketing) commercial communications;

We will not, without your express consent, provide your personal information to any third parties for the purpose of direct marketing.

Security of your personal information

We will take reasonable technical and organisational precautions to prevent the loss, misuse or alteration of your personal information.

We will store all the personal information you provide on our servers.

You acknowledge that the transmission of information over the internet is inherently insecure, and we cannot guarantee the security of data sent over the internet.

Disclosures

We may disclose your personal information to any of our employees, officers, agents, suppliers or subcontractors insofar as reasonably necessary for the purposes set out in this privacy policy.

In addition, we may disclose your personal information:

- to the extent that we are required to do so by law;
- in connection with any ongoing or prospective legal proceedings;

- in order to establish, exercise or defend our legal rights (including providing information to others for the purposes of fraud prevention and reducing credit risk);

Except as provided in this privacy policy, we will not provide your information to third parties.

International data transfers

Information that we collect may be stored and processed in and transferred between any of the countries in which we operate in order to enable us to use the information in accordance with this privacy policy.

Information which you provide may be transferred to countries (including the United States,) which do not have data protection laws equivalent to those in force in the European Economic Area. You expressly agree to such transfers of personal information.

Policy amendments

Your rights

You may instruct us to provide you with any personal information we hold about you. Provision of such information will be subject to:
